

PRIVACY POLICY

The internet website www.getssl.eu is owned and operated by Get SSL Ltd, Bulgaria.

1. Your personal and company information is used by us for the following purposes:

- To provide your company with the product or service you have purchased
- To verify you as a technical or admin contact of your company
- To be able to provide you with high quality customer support
- To reply to an inquiry, you've place in regard to our services
- To inform you if the service you have purchased is about to expire

As a reseller, Get SSL Ltd. is not directly issuing your certificate, thus the information you have provided is transferred to our Certificate Authority partners Comodo, DigiCert (which owns Symantec, RapidSSL, GeoTrust and Thawte) as well as Certum. They are GDPR compliant and do their utmost of maintaining the confidentiality of information provided by you. Their terms and condition apply

4. Payments. (Sub-Contractors). We may provide paid services and/or products. In this case, we use third-party services for payment processing. The payment processors we work with are PayPal and Braintree. We will not store or collect your credit card details.
